



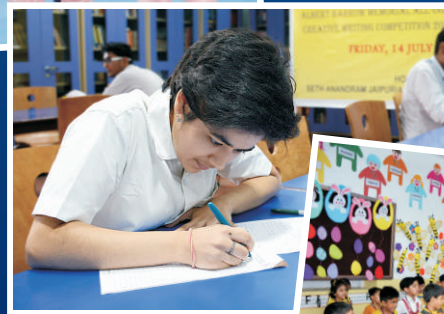

MANGO DAY

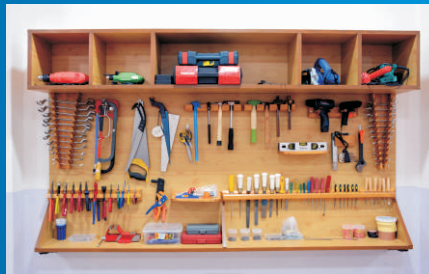


“Mango Day” was organized and our little ones participated in it with full gusto. Dressed in yellow, our kids bloomed like sun flowers.

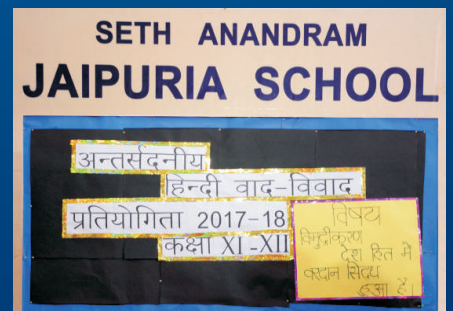
AFTER SKOOL – RJ HARI

MOCKTAIL PARTY

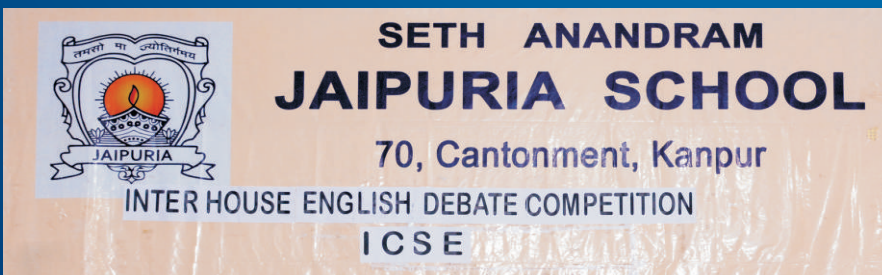


A Mocktail Party was planned for our Pre Primary section. The blooming buds relished the refreshing fusion of Lemon and Pineapple Juice.

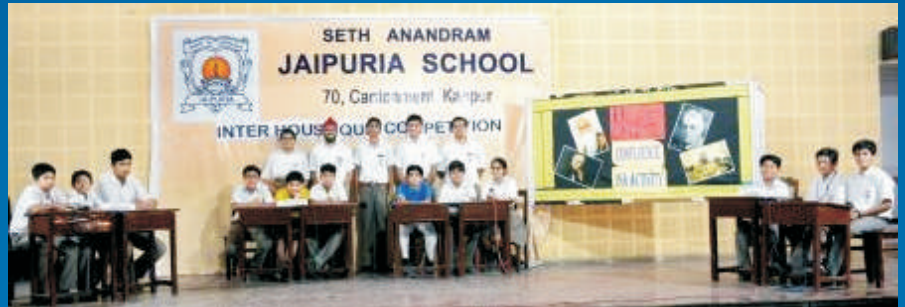
