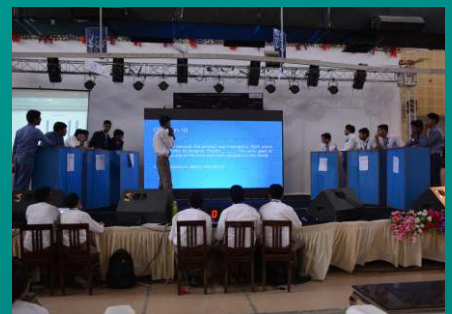

A VISIT TO RAMA KRISHNAN MISSION ASHRAM

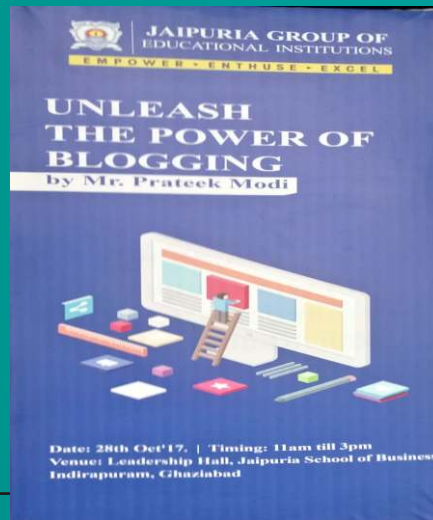
